1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India against the respondent for violating the direction issued vide judgment dated 22.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-21873-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 22.09.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-21873-2022 has been complied with and order dated 05.01.2024 has been passed, vide which, representation of the petitioner has been filed being devoid of merits.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
