The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 & 5 to decide the representation dated 15.07.2024 vide UID No.394473 & representation dated 29.07.2024 vide UID No.412947 (Annexures P-2 & P-4, respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Sukhjinder Singh around ten years ago and he is an owner of a Truck driven by him on private basis on account of which, he used to remain out of the house. Out of this wedlock, two female children were born. It is further submitted that on the pretext of demanding dowry, all the private respondents used to dominate the petitioner and taunt her that she did not give birth to a male child. He further submits that all the private respondents used to cause disturbance, harassment to the petitioner and resorted to physical violence. Further, the petitioner approached the official respondents No.4 & 5 several times to get her complaint registered against private respondents but no action has been taken by them. Thereafter, in this

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regard, the petitioner moved a detailed representations dated 15.07.2024 & 29.07.2024 (Annexures P-2 & P-4, respectively).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations dated 15.07.2024 & 29.07.2024 (Annexures P-2 & P-4, respectively) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations dated 15.07.2024 & 29.07.2024 (Annexures P-2 & P-4, respectively) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
