KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.47 dated 07.08.2024 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 IPC at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.
2. On the last date of hearing, it was brought to the notice of the Court by the State counsel that petitioner caused simple injury on the left leg of complaint with wooden danda and resultantly, the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court with direction to join investigation with the police.
3. Today, the State counsel on instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar made statement that in compliance of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined investigation and got effected recovery of wooden danda and that the petitioner is not required by the police for the purpose for further investigation or custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 05.09.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.
