AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

The appeal stands settled at Rs.12,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 11.09.2024 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lacs Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.3- Ram Dass with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.10.2024. However considering the fact that the learned Tribunal had apportioned the amount of compensation amongst the appellants and now learned counsel for the appellants wants the amount to be paid only to the appellant No.3-Ram Dass, we direct that in case of interse dispute/disagreement with regard to the apportionment of the enhanced amount, appellant No.3 shall be responsible to re-imburse the amount to other appellants as per the proportion determined by the learned Tribunal.

Failing compliance of the order by the Insurance Company, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
