Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of petitioners has been accepted vide speaking order dated 25.11.2024 read with order dated 28.11.2024 by granting them the benefit of Daily Wage / Ad hoc service and the actual financial benefits shall be released to petitioner No. 1 and the legal heirs of petitioner No. 2 within a period of two months from today.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /

concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of each of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
