1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125 dated 01.08.2024, under Sections 108 and 3(5) of B.N.S. registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, Punjab.
2. Vide order dated 03.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kanwaljit Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



6. In view of the above, interim order dated 03.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) B.N.S.S.
7. Petition stands allowed.
