

**BEFORE THE NATIONAL LOK ADALAT****FAO-6009-2018 (O&M) &****XOBJC-183-2019****Date of Decision: 14.09.2024****RELIANCE GENERAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD****.....Appellant****Versus****JAGIR KAUR AND ORS****.....Respondents**

In view of the agreed statements suffered by learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company as well as learned counsel for cross-objectors/respondent Nos.1 & 2, both the parties have compromised for a total sum of Rs.17,50,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already paid to the claimants as full and final settlement of their claim.

Learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company as well as learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 pray that the main FAO-6009-2018 be disposed of and XOBJC-183-2019 be allowed to be withdrawn as per settlement. In view of this FAO-6009-2018 is disposed of and XOBJC-183-2019 is allowed to be withdrawn.

Accordingly, a direction is issued to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/demand draft in the sum of Rs.17,50,000/- (Rupees Seventeen

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Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) in favour of cross-objector-respondent No.1-Jagir Kaur to be shared by the claimants/respondents No.1 & 2, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today.

In case, the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, the cross objectors/respondents No.1 & 2 shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on the said amount from the date of this order till the date of realization. The counsel for cross objectors/respondents No.1 and 2, may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The Office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel for the cross objectors/respondents No.1 and 2 as a receipt on record.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.

A copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the parties.
