Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the station from where the petitioner has been transferred has not been filled up and the petitioner has been transferred about 55 Kms away and that too without giving any valid reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioner intends to make appropriate representation so as to request that the petitioner be posted at a nearby station where the post is vacant and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Satnampreet Singh Chauhan, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case any representation

is received from the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with the law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 3 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible to post the petitioner at a nearby station keeping in view the earlier place of posting, the same will be done and in case the same is not possible, due reasons will be mentioned for the information and necessary action of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondent, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
