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1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that his pensionary benefits are not being released despite the fact that he has already retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the other hand, submits that keeping in view the disciplinary proceedings which were pending against the petitioner, the order of punishment has been passed wherein, the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been withdrawn, which order is

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not under challenge despite the fact that the same had already been passed
by the time the writ petition was filed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ
petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with
liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy before the appropriate
forum against the order by which his pensionary benefits have been
withdrawn.
