1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for setting aside the letter/order dated 28.08.2023 (Annexure P-2), vide which respondent No.4 ordered the recovery of Rs.14,57,030/- from the petitioner and withhold his pension on the ground of excess payments due to wrong fixation of pension.

2. Learned State counsel has produced a copy of order dated 02.04.2024, whereby the impugned order dated 28.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) has been reconsidered and the recovery ordered against the petitioner for a sum of Rs.14,57,030/- has been withdrawn and the regular monthly pension of the petitioner has been restored and arrears of pension for the period from August, 2023 to January, 2024 amounting to Rs.61,704/- has been transferred to the bank account of the petitioner on 06.02.2024. Copy of order dated 02.04.2024 is taken on record.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not opposed the abovesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
