MAIN CASE

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to release salary, increments and other due benefits along with interest w.e.f. 01.04.2009 to 10.02.2010 with further prayer to decide the representation dated 27.05.2024 (P-20) and to pass a speaking order in a time bound manner.

(2) In compliance of order dated 05.09.2024, learned State Counsel has produced photocopy of the communication dated 31.05.2024, which is taken on record as Mark 'X'. For reference, the relevant part of the aforesaid communication reads as under:-

"WAN Message"

From Police Haryana

To SP/KKR.

No.6823/E(II)-6 dated 31.05.24 (.) It is submitted that EASI Ram Bhagat No.485/KKR has submitted a representation against adverse remarks recorded in his ACR for the period from 01.04.2009 to 10.02.2010 directly to this office (.) In this regard, please direct EASI Ram Bhagat No.486/KKR (485/KKR) to submit his representation against adverse remarks for the said period through proper channel (.)

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(3) In view of the above development, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law, including making representation through proper channel to the quarter concerned.

(4) Disposed off with liberty aforesaid.
