1. Prayer in this revision petition is for issuance of directions to the learned Principal Judge (Family Court), Camp Court at Phul, District Bathinda, to decide DMC 1437/2021 titled as 'Jaswinder Kaur vs. Jagdish, which is pending for 08.10.2024, expeditiously, preferably within a period of 3 months.
2. Given the limited prayer, the issuance of notice to the respondent is dispensed with.
3. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and with his able assistance, have gone through the paper-book.
4. Copy of petition (Annexure P-2) indicates that the petitioner has filed petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (referred to as 'the Act'), which is pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Camp Court at Phul, District Bathinda. Various zimini orders placed on record reveal that the proceedings are going on in the said petition. Now, the case is fixed for 18.10.2024 for evidence of respondent.



5. Since the litigation is pending consideration for the last three years, learned Trial Court is directed to dispose of the matter within a period of six months from the date of the order.

6. It is to be noted that concept of right to speedy trial focuses on expeditious case resolution to enhance the efficacy and credibility of judiciary.

7. Needless to mention, parties to the case shall assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.

8. In view of the above, this revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.

9. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
