By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 22.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 22.10.2024, following order had been passed: -

It is inter alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on account of civil dispute between the co-accused Rajwinder Singh and complainant as per Annexure P-2. He submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the alleged injuries attributed to him are simple in nature. He further submits that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents and is ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel while referring to the status report submitted by the State has not disputed that the alleged injuries attributed to the petitioner are found to be simple in nature and there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and he is not having any criminal antecedents.

In the meanwhile, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from Investigating Officer of the case informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 22.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 22.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
