1. Both these petitions are decided together by this common order as the same have been filed for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for disobeying the order dated 10.04.2023 passed in CRM-M-16581-2023.

2. Reply dated 04.01.2024 by way of affidavit of Gorakh Pal, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ganaur, Sonipat, filed in COCP-3282-2023 in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the respondent(s) submits that pursuant to the order dated 10.04.2023 passed in CRM-M-16581-2023, necessary

cancellation report has already been presented before the concerned Magistrate, however, vide order dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure R-1), the said Magistrate has issued notice to the complainant for seeking his objections, if any.

4. Counsel for the petitioner in COCP-2831-2023 has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
