The learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him submits that the ground of challenge made in this writ petition relating to the fakeness of the matriculation certificate of the respondent concerned, after inquiry has been revealed to be unauthentic, as the said matriculation certificate has been declared to be authentic.
2. Consequently, the said ground becomes rendered infructuous, as such, the instant petition is also rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the permissible remedy to challenge the inquiry report whereby the matriculation certificate of the respondent concerned has been declared to be authentic.
