1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that earlier respondent No.6 gave a one complaint with the police against the petitioner and her son and the said complaint was filed by the police authorities after due inquiry into the matter. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that now again the respondent No.6 being not satisfied has given some representation to the police authorities wherein, the petitioner is being unnecessarily called to the police station in connection with the said representation. It is further submitted that petitioner is a lady aged about 53 years and is being unnecessarily harassed by the police on the behest of respondent No.6 whose daughter is already settled in England.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and has not disputed the fact that the police complaint lodged by respondent No.6 against the present petitioner was already filed. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Kahan Singh submits that thereafter,

petitioner has never been called to the police station in connection with any representation given by respondent No.6.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case with direction to respondents No.3 and 4 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner by calling her time and again to the police station concerned and in case any representation moved by respondent No.6 against petitioner is pending then to dispose of the same only in accordance with law.

5. The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
