Through the instant petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking the relief of 'regular bail' by the petitioner in case FIR No.444, dated 28.12.2020, under Section 22(c) of the the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).

2. Today, learned State counsel, has filed a reply, dated 12.11.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh. Ramesh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali, District Sirsa, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
