RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.106 dated 15.08.2024, under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.
2. Vide order dated 12.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.09.2024, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nadar Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.
5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners and has



submitted that an amount of Rs.4 lacs has not been deposited as contended before this Court on the last date of hearing,.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the amount would be deposited before the trial Court.

7. In view of the above, interim order dated 12.09.2024 is made absolute subject to deposit of payment of Rs.4 lacs by the petitioner before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and also in compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) B.N.S.S. In case the petitioners fail to deposit the amount as stated above within a week, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed and the present order would be of no avail to the petitioners.

8. Petition stands allowed.
