AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case vide COMA-85-2022, under Section 32 read with Section 17 (c), 18 (a) (I), 18 (a) (vi), 18 (c), 22 (1) (cca) read with Section punishable under Section 27 (D), 28A, 36 AC of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that in pursuance of order dated 05.09.2024 he was granted interim bail to the satisfaction of trial Court. Relevant part of the order runs as under:-

"Considering the aforesaid factual position, present petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar within 10 days from today and he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of said Court. Status report/compliance report be furnished."

3. It is pointed out that petitioner has already surrendered before the Court on 09.09.2024 and was released on bail and his bail bonds and surety bonds were duly attested and accepted by the Court. Now he is facing trial.

4. Aforesaid facts are confirmed by learned counsel representing respondent. Compliance report is also received from learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar vide letter No.560 dated 11.09.2024. Considering the aforesaid factual position, interim bail already granted in favour of present petitioner, vide order dated 05.09.2024, stands confirmed subject to the same terms and conditions.

5. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
