1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent.
2. Learned State counsel has placed on record statement of the petitioner recorded by ASI Manna Singh. As per the statement recorded, the petitioner has returned to her parental home and has categorically stated that there is no danger to her life and liberty from any person much less her family members; she does not require any security nor does she want any action to be initiated against any person.



3. In view of the statement made by the petitioner, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case and the same sands disposed off accordingly.
