1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite the grant of benefit by the higher authorities, implementation of the same has been declined by the Director School Education, Punjab vide order dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-10), which is causing prejudice to the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the claim of the petitioners has been kept in abeyance till the finalization of the seniority in the Master/Lecturer Cadre, which is arbitrary and illegal.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the seniority in the Master Cadre has already been finalized and keeping in view the said finalization, the seniority in Lecturer cadre will be finalized, which process is going to take approximately three months and after three months, whatever the relief the petitioners are found entitled for, will be extended to them within a period of eight weeks of the finalization of the seniority in the Lecturer cadre.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
