1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that his total length of service has not been taken into account for calculating the pensionary benefits as the adhoc service rendered by the petitioner w.e.f. 30.11.2004 to 22.03.2010 has not been taken into account as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits, which act on the part of the respondent-University is totally arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-14) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this



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stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. H.S. Batth, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-University.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 02.07.2024 (Annexure P-14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
