Prayer is for quashing of order dated 23.09.2022 (Annexure P-4), passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person in case having FIR No.57 dated 22.05.2020 registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was released on interim bail by the said Court in compliance of the previous order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in the present petition. The copy of the concerned order dated 09.11.2023 passed by the learned trial Court is taken on record.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 19.10.2023 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
