1. Through the instant petition, under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.317 dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 302 and 364 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 07.05.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Reply filed on behalf of the State by way of affidavit of Harinder Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pataudi, Gurugram is ordered to be taken on record.

State counsel on instructions from PSI Veneet Kumar apprised the Court that the trial is going on and already 21 witnesses are examined out of total 28 witnesses on behalf of the State.

Now be listed on 23.7.2024.

In the meantime, the learned trial Court is directed to make sincere efforts to exhaust the list of prosecution witnesses and to submit its report by the next date of hearing in this regard.



3. In pursuance to the directions issued by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court (supra), the learned trial Court concerned, has sent a report, and on perusal of which reveals that the trial is progressing, and a request for extension of one month time to exhaust the list of witnesses is asked for.
4. In view of the above request, the learned trial Court concerned, is further granted the time of one more month to exhaust the list of witnesses.
5. The instant petition is **dismissed**, as this stage.
