JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to act upon his representation dated 25.05.2024 (Annexure P-12).
2. The petitioner claims that he is working with respondent No. 5 i.e. Federal Mogul Goetze India Limited, Bahadurgarh, Patiala. He is suffering from lung disease, still Management is compelling him to do work in an area where there are issues relating to dust which is in violation of provisions of Sections 10 and 14 of Factory Act, 1948 read with Rule 67-P of Punjab Factory Rules, 1952.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service. He submits that on the complaint of petitioner, he was subjected to medical examination and found fit for duty. The petitioner needs to approach Labour Authorities, if his grievance survives.



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4. The petitioner concededly under the Factory Act, 1948 as well as Rules framed thereunder, has remedy to approach Labour Authorities for the redressal of his grievance.
5. This Court is sanguine of the fact that if petitioner approaches Assistant Labour Commissioner, the said Authority would look into his grievance.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
