1. As per the observations by the learned Family Court, Patiala, the petitioner is working as a Peon (Government Employee), in the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana and his gross salary for the month of



May 2024 is ₹57,210/- and his carry home salary is recorded as ₹40,210/- per month. Admittedly, respondent No. 1-wife is not working. Respondents No. 2 and 3-minor children are aged 11 years and 09 years, respectively. They are expected to be having educational expenditure.

2. Awarding of interim maintenance to the tune of ₹5,000/- per month to each of the respondent is in-resonance with the facts and circumstances on record, at this stage. The parties are yet to lead evidence to prove their allegations and counter-allegations.

3. No interference is required at this stage.

4. Consequently, the present petition stands dismissed.

5. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
