This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent/University to grant one month's salary to the petitioners in lieu of Leave Travel Concession (LTC) in terms of new Scheme dated 14.02.2023, Annexure P-10, regulating LTC for the contractual employees which has been forwarded to the State Universities by the Government vide office order dated 12.04.2023, Annexure P-11, for strict compliance.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the issue was adjudicated by this Court in LPA-1624-2024 titled *Surender Kumar and others v. Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and others*, vide order dated 19.07.2024, whereby the concerned University was directed to consider the aforesaid Scheme. He seeks similar direction to the respondent/University as well.



3. Learned counsel for the respondent/University does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

4. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of by directing the respondent/University to consider and take a decision regarding the new Scheme regulating LTC for the contractual employees forwarded to it by the Government vide office order dated 12.04.2023, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of four months of receiving a certified copy of this order.
