KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

- Through the instant petition, filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, a prayer is made for quashing of FIR No.195 dated 12.09.2019 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC, 1860, and under Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Phase-I, Mohali, Punjab.
- Learned State counsel submits that now the charges have been framed and even two prosecution witnesses have been examined so far. Further, the issues, which are raised before this Court, are purely disputed question of facts, which are to be adjudicated by the learned trial Court concerned.
- In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant the asked for relief to the petitioner. Accordingly, the instant petition is **dismissed**.
- However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to raise all such pleas, which are raised before this Court, before the learned trial Court concerned, at an appropriate stage of trial.
