The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* and for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for the release of detenue Shakila Khatun @ Nirmal Kaur, wife of the petitioner-Ranjit Singh, who is alleged to have been illegally detained by respondents No.4 to 6.

Today, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, petitioner remained unrepresented.

As per status report dated 10.10.2023 filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 by learned State counsel, it is being stated on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh that now detenue Shakila Khatun @ Nirmal Kaur, is residing with her husband and therefore, nothing survives in this criminal writ petition.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this criminal writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
