The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.26, dated 30.06.2024, under Sections 406,420 of IPC and under Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station NRI, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 04.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
