Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are senior citizens and are resident of Ludhiana and are unnecessarily harassed by respondent No.4 who is closely related to petitioner No.1. That respondent No.4 intends to grab the property owned by the petitioners by unlawful means. That respondent No.4 has also installed CCTV cameras to keep eye on the petitioners and the concerned photographs are Annexure P-6 to Annexure P-8 showing the installation of CCTV cameras and showing even respondent No.4 accompanied by armed gunmen. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already given representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that at present petitioners will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 and District



Magistrate to look into the matter and decide aforesaid representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) in accordance with law, within a time bound period.

- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that in case any such representation/complaint submitted by the petitioners is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, in a given time frame.
- 4. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
- 5. The petitioners being senior citizens are also given liberty to file fresh representations before respondent No.2 and District Magistrate, Ludhiana, in case, their grievance is not redressed at the earliest by the competent authority.
