The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No.09 dated 09.07.2024 under Sections 7, 7A of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 read with Section 61(2) of the BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase-1, Punjab, Mohali.

In compliance of order dated 11.09.2024, reply by way of affidavit of Inder Pal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Flying Squad-I, Punjab at Mohali, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.
