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‘4. That the further status of investigation and steps taken by the Special Investigation Team in this case are as follows:-

(i) That on 12.09.2024, Complainant was re-joined in the investigation of the case. She got recorded her supplementary statement under Section 161 of Cr.P.C. and also gave her handwritten complaint, which was taken into police possession as evidence. The complainant alleged that she has enquired on her level about the reason for the death of her husband, and she found that the accused, Renu W/o Praveen, was having illicit relations with her husband since 2019. She used to talk with her husband on his mobile number, 92559-01676, and her husband was also caught by her while talking with Renu W/o Praveen. She further disclosed that Renu W/o Praveen was pressuring her husband for solemnising marriage with her. On 27.08.2021, she called her husband in Dureja Guest House and made physical relations with him and then started pressuring him for solemnising marriage with him. He was pressuring to the extent that her husband ended his life by hanging himself with the veil of Renu W/o Praveen in Dureja Guest House in the presence of Renu W/o Praveen. True Copy of Complaint is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1.

(ii) That thereafter, the facts and circumstances of the case were verified by Sh. Anil Kumar, Incharge, CIA-3, Panipat and by Sh. Rajbir Singh. Incharge S.I.T/D.S.P, City, Panipat. Section 302 of IPC was deleted from the case and Section 306 of IPC was added in the case as per the nature of crime.

(iii) That on 13.09.2024, accused Renu W/o Praveen R/o Pathan Mohalla, Panipat was re-joined in the investigation of the case and was deeply interrogated with regards to the allegations against her. Finding incriminating evidence against her, she was arrested in due course of law. During investigation, she

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confessed to her crime and got recorded her disclosure statement. She also got demarcated the place of occurrence as per her disclosure statement. The further investigation of the case is still under progress. True Copy of Disclosure Statement is annexed herewith as Annexure R-2.

5. That hence, keeping in view of aforesaid facts, the present petition is liable to be dismissed being infructuous as the investigation of the case is being carried out by Special Investigation Team under the supervision of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Panipat as per the direction of the deponent and the respondent no. 6/ accused has been arrested as prayed by the petitioner. However, the police assure to abide by all the directions on priority basis as will be passed by this TA RHon'ble Court as per circumstances of the present case.'

In light of the above, learned State counsel submits that the investigation is making head way and challan would be presented to Court expeditiously. Consequently, nothing survives in the present petition and hence, the same may be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
