1. Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0335 dated 30.08.2023 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station Sohana, District S.A.S. Nagar.
2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegations made in the FIR are totally false and frivolous. From the bare reading of the allegation made in the FIR, it is apparent that the dispute among the parties is totally of civil nature. He submits that the petitioner has hired the complainant for her services for constructing the house. However, he raised the dispute regarding the payment for which she has already filed the petition before the Consumer Court. He submits that filing of the present petition is nothing but an abuse of the process of Court.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



5. However, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the case is under investigation as no challan has been filed. He prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedies before the authorities concerned as available to her under the law.

6. Allowed to do so.

7. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. However, the Investigating Agency is directed to take into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and conclude the investigation expeditiously preferably within a period of four weeks from today.
