SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0063, dated 19.06.2023, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC, and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).
2. Primarily considering the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise, as has been informed by Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage. It is also informed to this Court by learned counsel for the petitioner that statements before the Illaqa Magistrate/JMIC have been recorded qua the compromise dated 01.07.2023 (Annexure P-2).
3. In the light of above, this Court has no reason to disbelieve the aforesaid assertions, which are admitted factual aspects by the State as well. Hence, the present petition stands disposed off with a direction to the petitioner be released

on anticipatory bail on furnishing personal surety/security bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes before this Court that the petitioner will report to the Investigating Officer within a period of three days from today and in that eventuality be released on anticipatory bail forthwith.

5. Ordered accordingly.
