1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No. 63 dated 02.08.2024 under Sections 380 and 457 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sanour, District Patiala, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, this Court had notice the following contentions:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that primarily there is a civil dispute between the parties, which has been given the texture of criminal offence. He further submits that a civil litigation is already pending between the parties with regard to the property in question.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the

order dated 05.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 05.09.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
