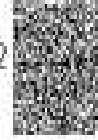
AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the impugned FIR No.156 dated 25.05.2021 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC and Section 132 of the Central Goods & Services Tax Act, 2017, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat, on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 10.01.2023 (Annexure P-4).0

2. Learned counsel for the complainant is opposing quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
