MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short, 'BNSS') in case FIR No.32 dated 27.03.2024 under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt, District Jalandhar.

2. On 05.09.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that a dispute, which is essentially of civil nature pertaining to an agreement to sell between the parties, has been twisted by being given a criminal colour.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 05.09.2024, the petitioner has joined

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investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harbhajan Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 05.09.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
