1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the cross case registered vide DDR No.43 dated 06.04.2023 under Sections 452, 323, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Annexure P-3) in case FIR No.66 dated 01.09.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.
2. Vide order dated 05.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



5. In view of the above, interim order dated 05.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

6. Petition stands allowed.
