Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners had preferred SA, which was dismissed in default on 03.06.2024. The petitioner had preferred an application for restoration of SA on 06.06.2024, which was listed for 03.09.2024 but due to non-functioning of DRT-II, the same could not be listed. He submits that he may be granted protection till its application is decided.

2. Issue notice to the respondent(s).
3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harsh Chopra, Advocate has put in appearance and waives service of notice to respondent No.2.
4. The petitioner or a litigant cannot be left remediless especially when the same has been provided by the statute.

In view of the limited prayer, the petition is disposed of with a direction that no coercive steps would be taken against the petitioners till the application for restoration preferred by the petitioners is listed for hearing. However, it is made clear that petitioners would not make any attempt to delay the proceedings including non removal of defects, if any.
