Petitioner (Rinku Singh) has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.77 dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (Section 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, added later on), registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the instant petition has become infructuous as the petitioner (Rinku Singh) already stands acquitted in the present case FIR No.77 dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-1).
