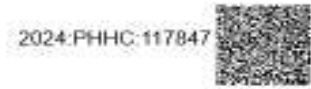

1. Present petition has been filed for directing respondents No.2 & 3 for taking appropriate strict legal action against respondents No.5 to 8 upon conducting free and fair inquiry into the representation/complaint (Annexure P-3 and P-6) of the petitioner and taking strict legal action against the private respondents for committing fraud and threatening the petitioner for playing fraud with the petitioner and the Land Revenue Department regarding fraudulently registration of two and half acre land deed No.102/1/519 dated 11/05/2023, mutation No.4600,4600/1 at Sub Tehsil Sahnewal by fraudulently using general power of attorney of deceased Harjeet Singh by claiming to be alive and for registration of the FIR against the accused persons/private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner has already filed the representation/complaint before respondent No.3/2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh

which has been marked to respondent No.4 i.e. Station House Officer,



Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana and D.S.P. He submits that the inquiry is pending till date and no final conclusion has been taken by the Investigating Agency.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and he on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh has submitted that the inquiry is pending with the Police Authorities and the same would be decided expeditiously.
- 5. After hearing counsel for the parties, the inquiry which is stated to be pending with the police officer/official is ordered to be completed within a period of four weeks from today. Respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to ensure the compliance of this order.
- 6. The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
