RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.08.2022 passed in CWP-18755-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Amrit Singh, Director Higher Education, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 25.08.2022 passed in CWP-18755-2022 has been complied with; the petitioner has been taken back in service and even 25% of the back wages, as ordered by the Writ Court, has been duly paid to the petitioner.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-
addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same before the Court where
the above-said writ petition is still pending adjudication.
