Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya
Nayaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (earlier Section 482 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure, 1973) for permitting the petitioner to travel USA from 05.09.2024
to 05.10.2024 or any other duration that this Court may deem fit, to attend
wedding functions on 12.09.2024 and 13.09.2024 (P-4) and on 27.09.2024 and
28.09.2024 (P-5) of relatives and close family friends in California, USA and
further prayer to exempt the petitioner from appearing in the trial emanating
from case FIR No. 13 dated 16.05.2023 (P-2) under Sections 13(1) read with
13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by the Prevention
of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 and Section 120B of the Indian Penal
Code, 1860, while travelling abroad.

(2) Learned State counsel has produced the copy of order dated
18.10.2024 passed by learned Special Judge, Faridkot, which is marked as 'X'
and taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

(3) Perusal of the above extract reveals that petitioner duly appeared
before learned Special Judge and surrendered his passport.



- (4) In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives in the present petition and the same be disposed off.
- (5) Ordered accordingly.
- (6) It is clarified that the above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case, in any manner.
