The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of Kalandra dated 15.09.2020 (Annexure P-5) under Section 182 of IPC; summoning order dated 24.09.2020 (Annexure P-6) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
