Challenge in the present petition is to the award dated 03.08.2023 passed by the Micro and Small Enterprises Facilitation Council, SAS Nagar whereby the claim petition filed by respondent No.2 has been allowed without adopting the mandatory procedure contemplated under Section 18(3) of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (**MSMED, Act 2006**).

On being confronted that there is a statutory remedy of appeal provided under the Section 19 of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative efficacious remedies available to it in accordance with law.
