HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 26.09.2024, as per which, the petitioner has been offered appointment to the post of Constable in Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) and has already been assigned Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) and the joining shall be made within a reasonable period as the same involves different agencies.
2. In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival in case, the petitioner is not made to join within a period of 04 weeks from

today and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
