Having argued the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition, to enable the petitioners to approach the Municipal Corporation, Panchkula, by filing a comprehensive representation, in the first instance, as regards their concerns/grievances.

Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana is present in Court on behalf of the respondents. At the outset, on instructions, he submits that, in fact, the subject tender and the work for collection of garbage from town and surrounding areas was assigned to M/s Pooja Consolation Co., 198, Opposite Civil Hospital, Sector 13, Sonipat (Haryana) and not to petitioner No.2 (M/s Pooja Traders). Be that as it may, he submits that in the event, any such



representation is received, the same shall be taken cognizance of by the competent authority. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

In the wake of the position sketched out above, as also the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition is accordingly disposed of.
