1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.49 dated 29.07.2023, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.
