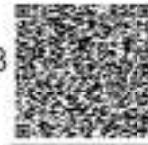

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 (Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector, Grade-2, Dabwali, District Sirsa) to decide partition applications bearing Nos.18, 19 and 20 dated 20.01.2020 in a time bound manner as the same are pending for last more than four years.

2. At this stage, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having been supplied to her. She, on instructions from Mr. Ashish Poonia, R.C., Naib Tehsildar, Dabwali, does not dispute the fact that the partition applications bearing Nos.18, 19 and 20

dated 20.01.2020 are pending before respondent No.2 for last more than four years. However, it is submitted that the said applications are now fixed for 24.09.2024, before respondent No.2; and the same shall be finalized at the earliest, and in any case, not beyond six months from the date already fixed (24.09.2024), subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities in respect of the partition proceedings.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners, keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further.

4. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
